<u>RCIA</u>

- We explored a new way to use the rites celebrated on Saturday, December 1 at the 5pm Mass was the Rite of Becoming a Catechumen (for those not yet baptized) and the Rite of Welcome (for those already baptized). This went well.
- Numbers are fairly stable now. At the moment we have:

 - 8 adults and 1 child to make a profession of faith and be confirmed 1 adult who is Catholic will also be confirmed
