#### New Business:

Special guest, Rev. Ron provided state of the ministries. Services offered include Adult Day and Food Pantry. Less than \$40,000 needed to complete Legacy Fund goal of \$250,000. Recognized the support of St, Gabriel both from financial standpoint and volunteers. FCHUM will have it's 30th anniversary in June of 2018. Rev. Ron will be retiring in early 2019; event is being planned for late 2018. Invited attendees to participate in/attend the Pennies from Heaven fundraising event on 5/12/18.

#### **Ongoing Items**

- Deacon Stephen covered discernment process to kick off in April 2018. Deacon Stephen has the lead and will take next steps to vet core team members and schedule first meeting in March. 6-10 people needed, Parish Council provided names for Deacon to consider for core team. Schedule proposed-Core team meeting in late March, listening session in late April, discern and decide meeting in mid May, wrap up in June 2018.
- Strategic Plan: St. Gabriel Park- Mike provided updates on land development; new land development is holding until wayfinding and playpark fundraising is complete. Father John provided update on bid process and noted that all properties will be vacant by July 2018. Sports Ministry- Adrian & Donna provided update on discussions with Amanda & Tim. Father John requested a needs assessment to determine next steps on forming a volunteer group and/or considering additional staff.
- Miranda facilitated signups for Parish Council mass, being held March 4, 2018, 10a.
- Reviewed committee reports: Admin- noted need to confirm Parish Council reporting/representation with Larry/Maria/Shawn. School- Working with Archdiocese on search for principal. Parish Council may be tapped for interview question input. Kathy noted that we are considering a 3rd kindergarten class for 2018/2019.
