Residency and Educational Rights

Students without fixed, regular and adequate living situations have the following rights:

- 1. Immediate enrollment in the school they last attended or the local school where they are currently staying, even if they do not have all the documents normally required at the time of enrollment (including immunization records, birth certificate, proof of guardianship, etc.) without fear of being separated or treated differently due to their housing situation;
- 2. Transportation to the school of origin for the regular school day when this is in the best interest of the student.
- 3. Access to free meals, Title I and other educational programs and transportation to extracurricular activities to the same extent that is offered to other students.
