
SCC MEETING MINUTES

FRIDAY, SEPT. 20, 2019

1. Principal Chatterton welcomed attendees who each introduced themselves. Minutes were not presented for approval as this was the first meeting of the 2019-2020 school year.
2. Principal Chatterton went over the accomplishments from last year. He also reviewed the schoolwide culture/climate SMART GOALS of the upcoming year. Kelly Poulson has been hired full-time. Part of her focus will be to continue implementing strategies to work individual students, who are very close to meeting grade-level reading standards. In addition to one-on-one tutoring, the school has started a measurement system that carefully measures progress of those below grade level. The school has also bought I-Pads for classrooms, and the school has hired a shared assistant principal and a full-time councilor.
3. Elections were held for SCC Chair and Vice Chair. Stacie Gaia nominated Audra Sorensen as chair, it was seconded by Trey Campbell. Sorensen was unopposed. The vote was unanimous in favor of Sorensen as SCC chair. Sorensen nominated Marie Carmel as Vice Chair, the nomination was seconded by Eric LeDuc.
4. PTA update was given by Stacia Gaia. She explained that the PTA has taken stewardship over the emergency kids for schools to make things easier on parents. The spring art fair funded the art teacher and part-time computer teacher.
5. The group discussed other SCC items of interest for the school year including safety at crosswalks, the development at 2100 S. and 2100 East, and active shooter training.
