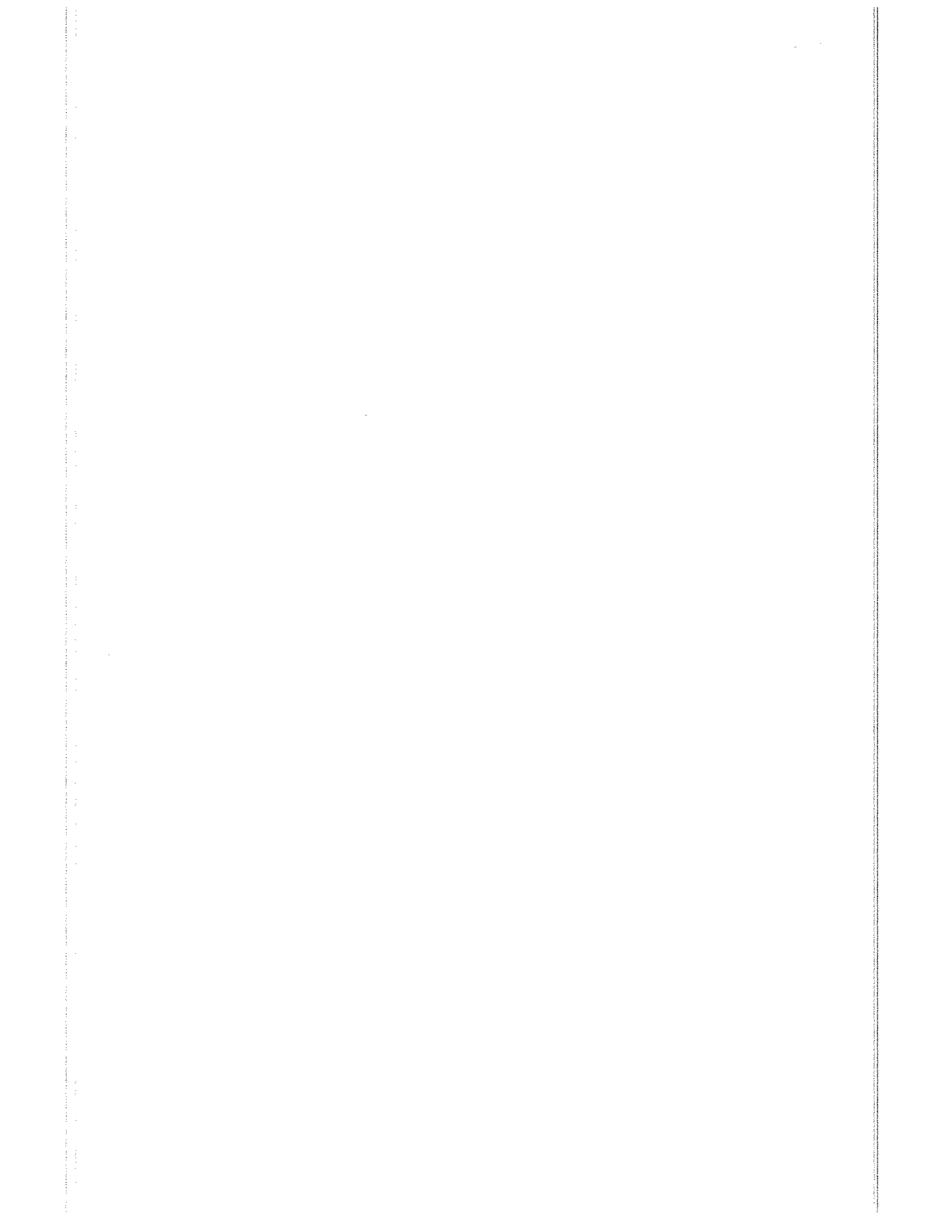
1. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT: There is positive news regarding our pull out reading groups. There are 13 students in the group and five students have made significant growth in reading and are being phased out of the group. Five students have achieved great accuracy in reading but need a little more help in comprehension. Two students are not quite there yet and need more help and one student is struggling and may need additional help.

2. TECHNOLOGY SAFETY: Nate Fotheringham led a discussion regarding cell phone use at school by students. Does the school have a policy regarding cell phones at school?

The policy states that cell phones and wrist phones need to be kept in the student's lockers during school hours. Some teachers allow the students to listen to music at recess and some teachers don't allow students to have their phones at all during the day. The Elementary handbook lists the policy about cell phones...parents need to receive this book.

After some discussion about parent/school responsibility it was suggested that a definite policy be drawn up about the use of cell phones at Dilworth.

3. DRESS CODE: Dilworth follows the District's dress code. There is a way to change the dress code but it involves many steps to finally change the code.
