Reviewed of minutes from previous meeting

Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship:

We had a guest Mr. Sam Quantz, Director of Technology, to discuss how all devices in the school are reviewed and filter for students and staff. Mr. Quantz explained that every program could be blocked depending on the category. For example, a program like Ready Rosie is categorized as educational, and a program like Pocker.com (gambling) is automatically blocked.

Mr. Quantz explained that digital citizenship is about how we behave and communicate with others through technology. Thus, school computers and technology should not be used for bullying others. Mr. Cooper provided examples of inappropriate things students have done. Mr. Quantz explained the procedures that administration takes when students are not following the Safe Technology and Digital Citizenship protocol. He also said that parents are given the technology policy, at registration, and are expected to follow this policy. If not, the child is given the opportunity to explain what they were doing. Then, the parents are notified, and if needed, technology privileges are taken away for a few days. Finally, Mr. Quartz also talked about all the devices and programs used in schools such as desktops, laptops, and iPads, Lexia, Wonders, Illuminate, ST Math, and Zearn Math.

Bus Zone: Parents need to be parking away from the bus zone and keep crosswalk clear for students to cross safely.
