Reviewed of minutes from previous meeting

Emergency Plan for School:

We had a guest Mr. Paul Schulte, Director of Technology, to discuss how schools prepare for different types of emergencies.

A Lockout:

A lockout is one of the most common emergencies. This type of emergency occurs when something happens in the neighborhood. All students are kept inside of the school and instruction continues as usual.

Active Shooter:

If able, the teacher and students may leave the school and/or find a safe place to hide, be quiet or fight.

Earthquake:

In case of an earthquake, students need to drop, cover, and hold on. It is recommended that students or staff take cover under a desk or a chair and hold on to it. If a student or adult is outside, stay outside. If a student or adult is inside the building, stay inside.

Intruder:

The school has cameras and bells to make sure this does not happen.

Evacuation:

A school evacuation will only happen in the case of an earthquake or hazardous spill. The meeting place, in the case of an evacuation, is Sherwood Park.

Upstart Preschool Program:

Matt talked about the program for at home preschool for 4-year-old children. This program provides computers and internet to get children ready for kindergarten.

Attendance:

The school understands when kids are sick with a fever, cough, vomiting, or the weather is bad or not safe to bring kids to school. However, if the child is not having any of the above symptoms, the child should be at school. If the child is not at school, he or she are missing important learning information.
