- District Calendar options (2020-2023) Option 1 was approved by staff and SCC
- · Budget is in good shape
 - Continuing to upgrade technology (smartboards, etc) and computers in library and lab
 - next years will be discussed in next 6-8 months

7:45am SIC (School Improvement Council) Report - Laura Hamilton

- SIC meeting update: Technology updates needed: voted to purchase more desktop computers
- Community Compact update**: completed, needs faculty review

7:55am School Board Representative Report -Katherine Kennedy

- Calendar proposals: >50% voted for Option 1 but it was sent back to Board to include Fall Break
 - · Calendar committee at the District level needs to be more transparent in the future, include parent representatives
 - It was requested that the District provide guidance on how to involve parents on Committees (e.g., Calendar, Hiring)
- School closures: District is losing 5-8,000 students in coming years, have lost 2,000 in past four years
 - Ensign and Newman Elementary are projected to lose enrollment
 - Overall there is low K-6th grade enrollment
 - · Junior High Enrollment is stable
 - District needs to look at innovative ways to attract students from outside of district.
 - Currently, those outside district are not allowed to participate in open enrollment
 - · Heather Bennett's son will fulfill her term on the Board.
 - Next Board meeting is May 7
