Principal Report:

SLCSD Policy Reviews – Marian talked about the Schools efforts to comply with SLCSD Policies on Religion and Emergency Plans (Teachers have new "Bug out" bags),

Shared Governance – Marian talked about the ways we try to honor the principles of Shared Governance.

Internet Safety & Filtering – Marian explained that this policy is posted in the front of the school.

Pledge of Allegiance – Marian copied the State policy regarding the reciting of the Pledge and explained how we respect others positions but do not allow disrespectful behavior.

C&A Information – Marian has talked with the other Principals with C&A programs and they are supporting the development of a written vision and "manual" to guide the C&A Program. Kristie asked a few questions about how the Program was working on the Middle School Level. Beth and Marian were able to answer her specific questions.

C&A - Kristie reported that Marian would be welcome at the next C&A Parent meeting. Ashlee asked about testing results for the students in the program. Beth reported that some of the test results could be misleading because the test scoring criteria is skewed to "formulaic" answers.

Neighborhood – Ashlee said approval has been given to install Speed-limit feedback signs on 6<sup>th</sup> East. Illegal parking has been an issue, no-parking areas will be painted and plainly marked.

PTA – Ashlee reminded us about the Hawk Walk on Sept. 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. The walk route will be around the school grounds. PTA is looking for a Vice President and Secretary.

Staff – Beth reported that SEP's will be Sept. 25 & 26<sup>th</sup>. Staff is working on Love and Logic training every Thursday morning. Shelley Rich has been given a contract by the district so the Art program is secure. Additional funding from the District has made it possible to hiring more Para-Pro's.

Other – Parents have been asking about getting shade or shade structures for the Playground. Marian will be asking when she has her Facilities Capital Improvement walk-through with the District in October. Marian invited SCC Members to come join the Walk Through.
