

SCC Notes for Jan. 7, 2019

Motion to begin meeting made and approved.

Review and Approval of minutes from last meeting, motion to approve made and seconded and all approved.

Chair report - Anthony: Anthony asked about having a mid-year review of goals and budget. Marian had that information and explained a few nuances about the report.

Principal's Report - Marian: Patti Jachim retired as of the first of the year. We have a new teacher - Abigail Abby Ryan in Kindergarten – Room 1. We also have welcomed Jessika Satterfield in 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, student teaching with Beth – Room 7, and Abigail Stanworth in Resource, aide to Karen – in Room 30.

Marian also reviewed the SMART Goals we will submit to the District for the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the year. These goals include using exit tickets to help teachers adjust math instruction, continuing to publish and display student writing covering genres that have not been covered before, and continuing to work on our walking goal. Beth talked about the requirements and expectations in teaching writing and language instructions from the perspective of the classroom teacher. Kristi S. talked about the efforts of the District to create more consistency across the District in efforts and expectations.

Student Data: We looked at the numbers of students who scored the lowest gains throughout the school in Math, Science, and Language Arts. The numbers indicated the greater number of students in the lower quartile were in Math, followed by Language Arts and then Science. We discussed the use of Land Trust Monies to support Math and Art instruction. Beth reported that the Faculty would like to keep Shelley, and do what they can to be cost-effective with Math supplies to put more money to special web-based math supplemental resources and Para-pros. Marian requested

that the SCC consider helping as much as possible to support Para-Pros and Shelley.
