Dear Parents and Guardians,

The Davis School District has been informed by the Davis County Health Department that Northridge High School has more than 15 confirmed cases of individuals with the COVID-19 virus over the last 14 days. According to the health department, any school with 15 or more confirmed cases across multiple settings in a school will result in a closure of the school building for 14 days. Because of this, Northridge High School will conduct remote learning beginning Wednesday, November 4. It is anticipated we will resume in-person classes on Wednesday, Nov. 18. This step is being taken to control the spread of the virus. In order to allow teachers time to prepare for this transition, there will be no instruction tomorrow, November 4. However, teachers will be available via email to answer any questions students may have. Please have your student check Canvas for information prior to reaching out to teachers.

This Thursday will be our first day of remote learning and it will be a B day as originally scheduled on the Davis School District calendar. Fridays will continue to be available for remote learning support. We will follow the traditional bell schedule and students will meet in their designated Microsoft Teams at the beginning of the class period. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of each class period, so please be sure to log in to the appropriate class in Teams on time.

There will be no Tutorial or Advisory during remote learning. The bell schedule we will follow is outlined below:

1/5 7:30-8:50	2/6 8:55-10:15	3/7 10:55-12:15	4/8 1:00-2:20
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Students are required to login and participate each school day in their live video classes. Daily video classes will be held in Microsoft Teams. The live video portion of classes begin promptly at 7:30 AM (1st/5th), 8:55 AM (2nd/6th), 10:55 AM (3rd/7th), and 1:00 PM (4th/8th). To maximize participation in on-line video classes, students should have their cameras on. Students are expected to be dressed appropriately for school.

During remote learning, students are still expected to engage with their classes and complete schoolwork as they would if they were attending class in the school building. For additional information specific to your student's classes, please have your students check the Homepage of each of their courses in Canvas. These will be updated throughout the day during our teacher workday tomorrow.

Also, consistent with provisions in the Utah Department of Health Covid-19 School Manual, all Utah High School Activity Association-sanctioned competitions will continue during the 14-day window. However, if there are three or more confirmed COVID-19 cases among group members, that group will be quarantined for 14 days.

School lunches will be available for pick-up from 12:15-12:45 each school day during remote learning for Northridge students.
