Last year, the land trust funds funded 50% of a new 3rd grade teacher and a playworks coach for recess. We saw increased success in our 3rd grade DIBELS scores, with 45% kids passing the test at the beginning of the year and 56% passing the test at the end of the year. We also saw a 6% increase in language arts across all grades.

VI. Update on traffic flow and student leadership

Student leadership committee is off to a great start and they have already met once with Dan.

VIII. Questions, concerns, etc.
