- > Welcome
 - Karen Pynes and Laura De La Cruz were excused from the meeting so that could volunteer in the school store today.
- Bennion Buck Store
 - Had to postpone until today because volunteers did not come on the 23rd. Laura and Karen are covering the store today for us.
 - We are needing more volunteers for future store dates. Next time is December 11th. Erin will coordinate volunteer sign ups for it.
- Detaining after school
 - Went over handout
 - District asked to share this information with SCC
 - Need to communicate this information with all parents. SCC concerned about how it is worded. Suggestion to send small statement on Class Dojo with reference to full statement/policy at District if they want more information.
- > 90 Day Plan
 - Next data collection will be on October 30th.
 - Focusing on reciprocal teaching and student engagement.
 - Last collection of data showed we were where we were last year, so have not lost and ground.
- Safety Survey
 - Looked a data shared by Ms. Cordova.
 - SCC feels that opening up the discussion on what bullying actually is, making sure the students understand it might help improve results.
 - Will be doing the survey again in January.
 - Concern brought up about bullying that is happening in places where adults are not present (like the bathrooms). What can be done to help?
 - Teacher have been talking in community circles about what bullying is vs just being mean
 - Counselor is also discussing issue in her counseling lessons
 - Members want to have students be able to discuss appropriate responses to being mean, and how to build their community.
 - The shared file has resources for teachers to be able to use.
 - Character traits in daily announcements examples are being shared to help explain
 - Suggested to send home information weekly about that week's character trait, and encourage parents to work with students at home.
 - "Fill Your bucket" books was suggested

 - Carrie will send out the links to them again to all members.
 - Will also put the links on Class Dojo for other parents to view as well.
