4. CSI Update: Bennion has recently been designated as a "Comprehensive School Improvement (CSI)" school under Title 1, Part A: School Improvement and School Turnaround. Bennion was among 3 schools in the district along with other schools in the state who performed in the lowest 5% of Title 1 schools over the past three years on average according to the percentage of points earned under the school accountability system. Schools identified as CSI schools under Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) will participate in required systemic changes, including a schools needs assessment and root cause analysis, establishing a school improvement committee; and developing a plan that will lead to excellence for each student. The three school that were designated as CSI schools in the SLCS D were: Bennion, Meadowlark and Rose Park. Bennion and Rose Park were above the bottom 15% last year.

## **Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI):**

### *CSI Low-Performing Title I Schools:*

- Method: Identify the lowest performing 5% of Title I schools based on the Utah Accountability System
  - Length of Identification: Minimum of three years, no more than four years
  - Frequency of Identification: Every three year
  - First year designation will begin during the 2018-19 school year
  - The USOE has scheduled a meeting with all CSI school's on March 20, 2019 to receive further details.
