

ON-CAMPUS BOARDING RESIDENCE

Totino-Grace has an on-campus boarding residence which allows domestic and international students to live on campus. The building is safe and secure, with its own entry, while physically connected to the school.

Each student enjoys their own furnished bedroom, a benefit for privacy and independent and focused study time. Separate boys and girls wings have shared, single-gender bathroom facilities and recreation space. A fitness center, outdoor courtyard, laundry, and common rooms for study and entertainment are also benefits of the Totino-Grace boarding residence.

The Boarding Residence Director lives on site and Residence Assistants are there to assist. Frequent local outings are a highlight for boarding students and offer a unique opportunity to explore all that Minnesota/the Midwest has to offer.

NEW OPPORTUNITY FOR GRADUATES PURSUING COLLEGE IN MINNESOTA

Totino-Grace and the University of St. Thomas, in St. Paul, Minnesota, have partnered to provide a special. International students who hold a valid F-1 visa, graduate from Totino-Grace, and meet specific admission standards will automatically be accepted to the University of St. Thomas upon submission of their application form, transcripts, and satisfactory proof of English proficiency. In addition, eligible applicants will receive an annual merit-based scholarship valued at 40% - 70% of current tuition.

ENROLLING AT TOTINO-GRACE



APPLICATION AND ENROLLMENT STEPS

Students interested in enrolling at Totino-Grace must complete an application file and participate in a Skype interview (to assess English language proficiency) with school administrators. Once contingent acceptance has been issued, a contract and enrollment fee are required to secure enrollment.

SEVIS AND I-20

Totino-Grace provides all international students with assistance in completing their SEVIS profile. Visit <https://studyinthestates.dhs.gov/students> for information on visas. An I-20 will be provided once the enrollment process is complete. The cost is included in the enrollment fee and Totino-Grace will process the I-20 and mail it to the enrolled student

TUITION AND BOARDING FEES

Totino-Grace issues fees for tuition as well as an enrollment and technology fee. Students residing in the on-campus boarding residence have an additional fee that includes room and board, transportation, meals outside of school hours, events and activities applicable to all boarding residents, as well as additional services and benefits.

SCHOLARSHIP FOR BOARDING RESIDENCE STUDENTS

International students who are new to Totino-Grace and will reside in the boarding residence are eligible for a \$5,000 scholarship.
