

FINANCIAL summary

NVCA reported net operating loss of \$226,669 for the fiscal year 2019–2020. This amount included debt service payments of \$897,333 and the increased costs for staffing and program development for the 2020–2021 academic year.

For 2019–2020, total income from tuition, fees, programs, development, and grants was \$6,515,443. Development/other income of \$939,781 subsidized operating and interest expenses of \$587,918. Non-operating contributions of \$2.5 million* were used to reduce building debt and subsidize losses incurred by the pandemic.

*This includes \$501,000 from the Payroll Protection Act.
