

Falcons After School Behavior Expectations

Please note the following criteria students must meet in order to enroll in Community School Clubs (Minnesota Statutes, section 124D.68, Subdivision.). Students need to follow the established FCS these rules:

- Follow verbal instructions and directions provided by Community School staff and supervisors;
- Demonstrate age-appropriate cooperative play and work behaviors (i.e., turn taking, sharing, etc.) in both small and large group activities with minimal adult supervision;
- Work independently without disturbing others when assigned individual tasks;
- Safely and successfully transition from one activity to another, and from one location to another with minimal adult supervision; and
- Refrain from hitting, kicking, biting, and other forms of physical aggression toward other students and staff.

By participating in any FCS club activities, students and parents agree to follow any and all rules and positive behavioral expectations established by Faribault Public Schools (FPS) and the FCS. Failure to follow these rules may result in disciplinary action. The following are examples of positive behavioral expectations:

- Respect and obey FPS and FCS personnel (ex: club leaders, teachers, bus drivers, cafeteria workers, etc.) at all times.
- Respect other students and their property at all times.
- Use appropriate language at all times.
- Follow all instructions or requests given by FCS staff at all times.
- No fighting, harassment, intimidation, or bullying at any time.

Failure to meet any of these rules and expectations will result in the following disciplinary actions:

1. First offense – Verbal warning and conversation with parent/guardian.
2. Second offense – Conversation with parent/guardian and one week suspension from FCS activities.
3. Third offense – Conversation with parent/guardian and student will be removed from the club roster.
