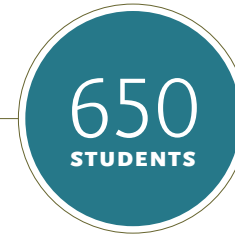

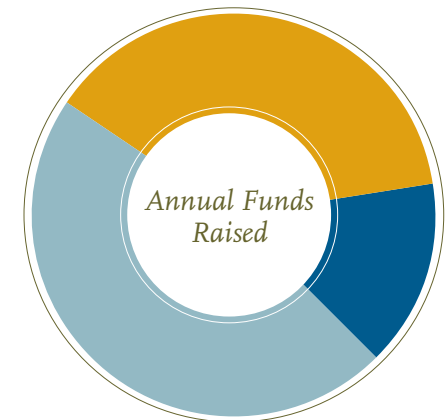
THE ARTS
