
NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY

POWERSCHOOL

How to Set up Powerschool Email Notifications

The Parent Portal provides real time access for families to their child's grades. PowerSchool also offers parents the opportunity to have daily, weekly, bi-weekly and monthly emails sent to their email accounts. Please remember that teachers are required to update their grades every two weeks.

To set up Email Notifications in Powerschool:

1. Log into **Powerschool** (<https://hamden.powerschool.com/public/home.html>).
2. On the left-side navigation bar, click on **Email Notification**.
3. Select the information you would like sent to you, and how often.
 - If you have other email addresses that you would like this information sent to, enter it in the **Additional Email Addresses** field.
 - If you have more than one child attending Hamden MS, check mark the option to **Apply these settings to all your students**.
 - If you would like Powerschool to send you an email right away, check mark the option to **Send now**.
4. When you are finished click on **Submit**.
