Membership Requirements

Frederica Chapter of National Honor Society

Prior to applying for induction a student must provide written documentation that he/she has met the following leadership and service requirements:

- A. leadership roles, at least one
- B. individual community service activity, at least one
- C. community service involvement, demonstrated continuously

To be inducted a student must additionally meet the following academic and honor requirements:

- A. Cumulative non-rounded numeric average of 85 or higher
- B. Be in the 11th or 12th grade
- C. Have completed at least two full semesters at Frederica Academy
- D. Be of good character with no Honor Council Violations
- E. Receive two supporting Upper School Teacher Recommendations
- F. Take the appropriate course load as approved by the College Counselor

To remain a member in good standing an NHS student must:

- A. Maintain a **non-rounded cumulative average of 85 or higher**. If the cumulative numeric average drops below 85, the student will be contacted and his/her membership suspended. The member may be re-instated if they bring his/her GPA into compliance. Grade compliance will be checked at the end of each semester by the NHS Advisors with the registrar.
- B. Complete **at least one individual service hour** each school year; "individual" is service the student has not completed alongside another group, club, organization, etc. See part E for documentation.
- C. Participate **in one NHS community service activity** each year to be determined by the NHS Advisors.
- D. Complete at least <u>TEN hours</u> of community service each school year (hours spent on parts B and C above count towards the required total hours).
- E. Submit proper documentation to the NHS advisors as soon as you serve. Parents/Guardians cannot verify your service. Email documentation from the adult verifying your service is preferred. The attached form can also be completed for verification. All ten hours must be properly documented and submitted to NHS Advisors no later than the Monday after Spring Break (Monday, April 12, 2021).
- F. Continue to exercise good leadership and character.
- G. Continue to take the appropriate course load as approved by the College Counselor. A student may be placed on probation if he or she switches from Honors or AP classes to regular classes during the course of membership or fails to carry at least four academic subjects.
