

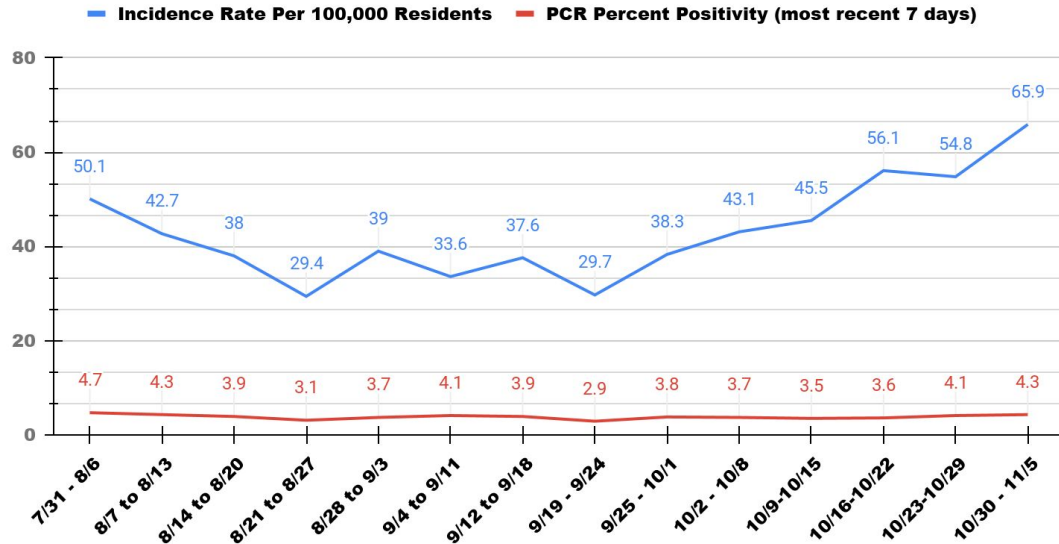

Health & Safety Plan

- Redundant/multi-layered safety measures
 - Face Covering
 - Ventilation
 - Physical Distance
 - Self Screen, Reporting
 - Good Hygiene Practices - washing hands often, cleaning high touch surface
- Stay Home When Not Feeling Well

Response to a Confirmed Case

- Information from student, parent, and/or employee
- Context and circumstances surrounding exposure
- ACHD consultation - public health experts
- Relevant internal team (Superintendents, Principal, Nurse, Coach, etc) conducts a thorough review and determines a recommended course of action
- Superintendent determines whether school is to remain open or close
- Administrators inform staff, families, and School Board.

Communication

- When do we communicate with families and staff?
 - **Emails are sent** to staff, families, and School Board when a positive case is confirmed in a school
 - **Close contacts** are contacted by Deanna Hess, District Health Services Chair and/or ACHD
 - **Covid-19 Dashboard** is updated
 - **School communications** are posted on the web
