Only students get out of their car.</li> <li>• Families of kinder students please park and walk your kinder child to the kinder gate. (no parking in car line)</li> <li>• 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade will enter through the large gate located by the MPR</li> <li>• Only staff and students are allowed to enter campus. No visitors or volunteers are allowed until further notice.</li> <li>• Any students which arrive earlier than 8:15a.m., will be asked to wait in their car until 8:15a.m.</li> <li>• Villa Staff will be welcoming students and will direct them to their classroom.</li> <li>• All students will go directly to their classroom as they arrive</li> </ul>	<p><b>COVID Symptoms Area</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• There will be a designated area in the office for students showing COVID symptoms and a different area for students with Non-COVID symptoms</li> <li>• Please make sure the school has your most updated phone number so you can be reached quickly if your child is not feeling well</li> </ul> <p><b>Materials in Class</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will be provided individual school supplies, so there will be no need to share supplies. You are also welcome to send your own supplies and each teacher will give you specific suggestions.</li> </ul> <p><b>PPE and Cleaning</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please send your children to school wearing a mask every day.</li> <li>• County's Guidelines: -K-2 face coverings strongly recommended -3-5 face covering required</li> </ul>	<p><b>Dismissal Times</b> K-3: 11:30 4-5: 11:40</p> <p><b>Lunch</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grab and go lunch will be provided for students to take home and eat. The bag will include multiple meals for students to enjoy that day and the next.</li> </ul> <p><b>Exits/Dismissal Procedures</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teacher will walk their class to the designated pickup area in the front of the school and assist with dismissal.</li> <li>• Students will be placed in rows by class to wait for their parent.</li> <li>• Parents will pick up students in the car line.</li> <li>• Parents that walk to pick up their children will wait in the designated area.</li> </ul> <p><b>Boys and Girls Club</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No after school programs available on site until further notice.</li> </ul> <p><b>Bus</b></p>

	<p>and their teacher will be waiting for them in the classroom.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• _____ will take the temperature of each student as they enter the classroom and assess for any symptoms indicating the child is ill. A temperature of 100 or higher is considered a fever and the student will be sent to the office. The office will be waiting for students and will contact parents immediately and provide the information indicating the child is ill. Please do not send children to school if they are not feeling well.</li> <li>• No breakfast will be served at school. Please ensure children eat prior to arriving at school.</li> <li>• Late students will go directly to the office for a temperature check.</li> </ul> <p><b>Bus</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Bussing will be available for students. Students must have a bus pass to board a bus and must be wearing a face mask at all times.</li> <li>• Bus students arriving to Villa prior to 8:15a.m. will be supervised in the MPR by staff. Students will be directed to their classrooms at 8:15a.m.</li> </ul>	<p>-Villalovoz is asking all students to wear a face mask for everyone's safety.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Please report any medical needs of your child to our school so we can prepare a plan of action to ensure they are safe.</li> <li>• All rooms have disinfectant and spray hand sanitizer. Students will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer each time they enter and exit their classroom. You may also send a small hand sanitizer to school with your child.</li> <li>• All classrooms will be cleaned.</li> </ul> <p><b>Restrooms/Water Fountains</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Restrooms are disinfected and cleaned regularly throughout the day.</li> <li>• Each class will have laminated passes. Each bathroom will have limited access indicated by a number of command hooks on the door. For example, no more than 2 students at a time, there will be 2 command hooks on the door. Student places pass on the hook visible from the outside since doors are propped open. Those waiting will wait outside the bathroom, social distancing</li> <li>• Drinking fountains will not be available. Please send your child with a water bottle.</li> </ul> <p><b>One directional Facing/Seating</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will sit in one direction facing the front of the class.</li> <li>• Primary grades that use tables will space students out.</li> <li>• Students are allowed to bring their backpacks.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students must have a pass to board the bus.</li> <li>• Students must wear a face mask at all times when on the bus.</li> <li>• If a student becomes ill during the school day, the student will not be allowed to use the bus in the afternoon. Parents will need to pick up the student from Villalovoz.</li> </ul>
