



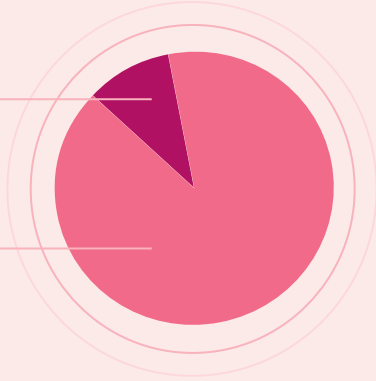

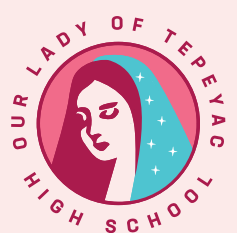

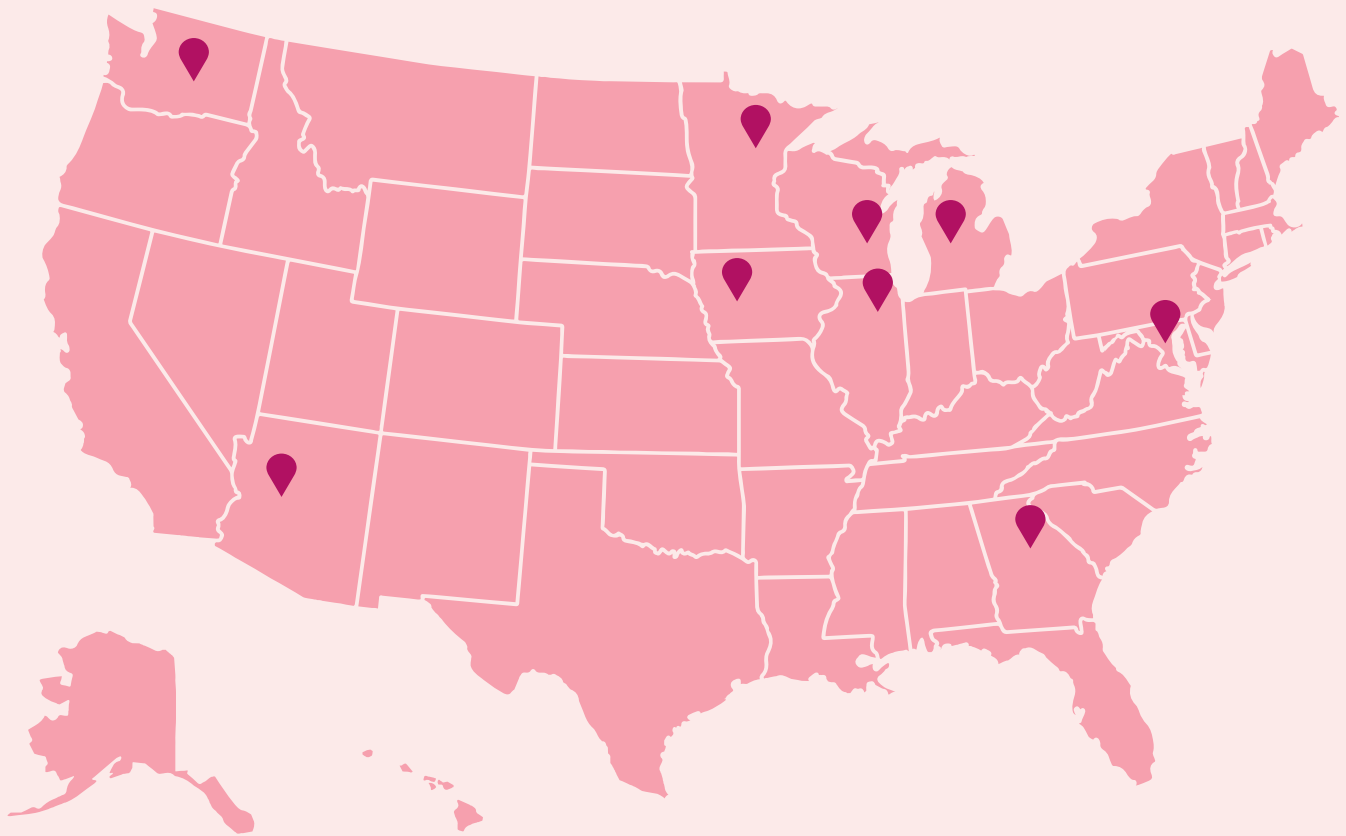


# The Class of 2020 Exceeded Our Expectations
