	6 th grade:
	o For core lit, 6 th grade wants to stick with D'Aulaires

Book of Greek Myths. Great SS connection. Students really engaged with mythology, read lots of modern retellings. References to mythology all over our culture.

- For second core lit text, group deciding between Look Both Ways and Hero Next Door. All group members will read both books for next meeting.
- o Note: Flying Lessons given to 7th grade
- Group thinking it would like to pilot both Look Both Ways and Hero Next Door to see which is "meatier" and which students engage best with
- Supplemental menu: Group keeping everything members had vetted and approved. Half-way through list. Would love to arrange titles, so list makes sense for Lit Circles/teachers

7th Grade:

- Added *Outsiders* back into the core lit possible titles pool.
- Group started voting on 2 favorites. List includes: Refugee, Flying Lessons, They Called Us Enemy, Other Words for Home, Booked, Outsiders
- o Some group members still making up their minds
- o Group members will read top contenders for next meeting and vote
- Supplemental menu: Group highlighted all their "yesses." Did not finish going through list and have not started to categorize texts
- Group currently thinking a pilot will not be necessary but will check in with grade-level teachers to hear what they think

8th Grade:

- o Group decided to keep Twelve Angry Men as core
- Group considering Fresh Ink and Long Way Down as possible core titles. Everyone in group will read both titles before next meeting
- However, those who had read Fresh Ink weren't convinced it was the best choice. Quality of stories a little spotty
- Group thinking it may need more time to decide on core
- o Group did not discuss piloting
- o Group worked its way through the supplemental menu and is about half-way

Suggestion: When we complete supplemental menus, can we sit down with elementary and double-check if any books are duplicates?
