



Dear Parents and Guardians,

November 11, 2020

Davis School District, with the assistance of Davis County Health Department, has identified Shoreline Junior High as currently having more than 15 confirmed COVID-19 cases over the past 14 days. According to the health department, once a school exceeds 15 confirmed cases across multiple settings the school will be closed for 14 days. Shoreline will be in soft closure beginning Thursday, November 12th and ending Thursday, November 26th. It is anticipated we will resume in-person classes on Monday, November 30th. This step is being taken to control the spread of the virus.

To allow teachers time to prepare for this transition, there will be no instruction for students tomorrow, November 12th. Teachers will be available to answer questions or concerns remotely on Friday, November 13th. Virtual classes for students will begin on Monday, November 16th. As we move to remote instruction for students, we will continue to follow the Davis School District calendar and school bell schedule. Please note the following student expectations which will provide for consistency, attendance tracking, and allow teachers to address student concerns regularly.

- **This soft closure will not follow the spring soft closure or "learn at your own pace" model.** During remote learning students are expected to engage in their classes and complete schoolwork as if they were attending class in-person.
- **Students should plan to join their classes each day through a video session** with their teachers during their regularly scheduled class time. Students are encouraged to join with their camera on, so they fully engage with the online classroom experience.

Many teachers have already provided information to students about how to join video conferencing sessions for their class. If students do not know how to join for a specific class, they should first check the homepage and announcements in Canvas for that course. If they still need assistance, students should message the teacher through Canvas. SHARK Time will be for teacher office hours. Students who are struggling should reach out to their SHARK Time teachers for additional assistance.

Lastly, Shoreline students in need of Grab 'n Go lunches during this time can pick up their meals between 10:00 am. and 10:30 am. at Layton Elementary, Centennial Junior and Legacy Junior.
