Schedule and Expectations

- Daily remote classes will follow the current district calendar and school bell schedule.
 - 1/5 periods 7:30
 - 2/6 periods 8:55
 - 3/7 periods 10:20
 - 4/8 periods 1:05
- Teachers should be available with “office hours” during their normal STAND class.
- Students will log-in virtually (camera on) for the first 15 minutes of each class. This will allow teachers to take attendance, engage in face-to-face instruction, and respond to any student questions.
- This will be conducted just like “traditional school” - students will just be joining the class virtually.
- **Students will be marked absent if they do not join their virtual meetings.**

Student FAQ's

Q: Am I required to join for the 15 minutes?

A: Yes! You should plan to keep your current school routine during this time. Joining classes will help you stay on track and give you the opportunity to continue to talk with your peers. It is also good for your emotional and mental health to wake up, get ready, and engage with others each day.

Q: What if I have a problem with my school issued computer?

A: Our school STS (Mrs. Lusk) will still be available to help. You can contact the main office to set up an appointment time with her so she can either trouble-shoot with you virtually or you can come to the school and exchange your device.

Q: How do I know what to do on Monday?

A: If teachers have not already walked you through the plan for remote learning days, they will post an announcement or instructions on their Canvas home page by Friday. Look in all your courses Friday afternoon so you are ready to go on Monday morning.

Q: What if I was scheduled to drive with Drivers Ed?

A: Drivers Ed students will still maintain their driving schedule. If you have concerns about joining your driving group, contact your teacher.
