

2020 - 2021 school fees

Please note that our tuition fees are inclusive of the following:

- Primary students receive all classroom consumables (e.g. textbooks, notebooks, pens, pencils, etc.).
- All Secondary students (Bac Français, English International Programme, IBDP) are provided with an individual school-owned tablet device including all software/apps/digital textbooks and resources needed for our academic programme. Paper notebooks/exercise books, writing paper for assignments and pens and pencils must be purchased by families.
- The lunch programme is compulsory and consists of a healthy and balanced daily lunch cooked on the premises by our award-winning school caterer.

B. School Fees.

Parents are offered two payment options: monthly or termly

Payment by monthly instalments: Parents may pay fees by monthly instalments. Those wishing to make use of this option should contact the Finance department on payments@lyceeinternational.london to arrange a schedule. Contact should be made before the termly payment option becomes due.

Payment by termly invoice: Parents are invoiced termly and tuition fees are due prior to the start of each school term.

Discount for parents with four or more children in the school: there will be a discount of £1,000 for the year, for the fourth and any subsequent children.

1. Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS): for children aged 3 and 4

Pending sufficient enrolment and Department for Education authorisation, we will be launching our Early Years Foundations Stage in September 2020. This will be for children aged three and four, and will lead to Year 1/ Grande Section at the age of 5.

Families with children joining in Pre-Reception/ Petite Section will receive a two-year discounted launch rate*, while those joining in Reception/ Moyenne Section will have a one-year discounted launch rate*.

We may also offer an Extended Hours Programme from 4pm-6pm every day, for an additional fee, subject to a minimum number of children enrolling in the programme.
