We will also be comparing and ordering objects and numbers in a variety of contexts. We will be doing this practically and using pictures.

Within learning journey, the children will continue thinking about castles and about how they have changed throughout history. We will be introducing the children to a learning platform called Purplemash and how it can be used. You will be receiving more details about this.
