




Dear Parents and Carers 09.11.20

This week we will be exploring Fireworks and Bonfire Night through a range of creative activities— including poetry, song and dance. The children will be making their own firework pictures and attempting to write firework sounds using their phonic knowledge they have learned so far.

In maths we will be further exploring repeating patterns by making firework arrangements.

In PE we will be further developing ball skills by rolling a ball with control along with continued practise of catching a large ball.

In music we will continue to learn the sounds of familiar percussion instruments.
