Strict Physical Distancing | No Large Gatherings

OPERATING HOURS:

- M-F 7:00 am 7:00 pm
- Saturday = typically closed
- Sunday = Christ Community Church

STUDENT ARRIVAL & BEGINNING OF EACH CLASS:

- Everyone will have a face covering upon arrival to school.
- Exterior doors disinfected upon arrival
- Exterior doors propped open beginning of day
- Classroom doors propped open
- Students attending a class will enter/exit through assigned exterior doors:
- Backpack lane assignment for each classroom. All space will be designated:
 - Choir & Music = right hallway/ under benches
 - Band/Orch = band room, designated space
 - Ceramics = left hallway/ bottom of benches
 - o Mac Lab = in classroom
 - Theatre = left hallway/ under benches
 - Arena Classroom = classroom lobby
 - HS Gym Classroom = hallway leading to classroom
- Students should place backpacks in designated spaces and use the assigned sink to wash hands with soap & water during classtime. (Teachers will train and oversee.)
 - Choir Rooms = lobby restrooms
 - Band Room = (end of class) lobby restrooms

YELLOW

<u>Modest</u> Physical Distancing | Limited Large Gatherings

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 - Band/Orch = right hallway/ top of benches
 - Ceramics = left hallway/ bottom of benches
 - Mac Lab = in classroom
 - Theatre = left hallway/ under benches
 - Arena Classroom = classroom lobby
 - HS Gym Classroom = hallway leading to classroom
- Students should place backpacks in designated spaces and use the assigned sink to wash hands with soap & water during classtime. (Teachers will train and oversee.)
 - Choir Rooms = lobby restrooms
 - Band Room = (end of class) lobby restrooms

- Mac Lab = lobby restrooms
- Ceramics = ceramics sink
- Theatre = dressing rooms
- Arena Classroom = classroom sink
- HS Gym Classroom = classroom sink
- Students will be mindful of distancing when waiting in line to wash hands.
 Floors will be marked where lines form. (Teachers will monitor)
- Parents should send all equipment and supplies with students and refrain from unnecessary entrance to school buildings.

Before The End Of Each Class:

- Exterior Doors disinfected
- Exterior Doors propped open
- 5 mins before the end of each class: Students will disinfect equipment, shared supplies, and classroom surfaces. (Teachers will train & oversee).

End Of The Day Routine:

ESI Cleaning includes wiping down all door handles and bathroom stalls

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MOTION AND MOVEMENT FOR WARRIOR HALL AUDITORIUM ASSEMBLIES

- Maximum audience: per ADH guidelines
 - Likely 1 grade per assembly (approx 125 people)
 - Two seats separating each participant (for performances, families may sit together)

• Before Assembly:

- Exterior doors disinfected
- o Restrooms disinfected
- Exterior doors propped open
- Attendees enter through front doors
- Attendees will wear masks
- Attendees exit through side exterior doors based on side of auditorium in which they are sitting

MOTION AND MOVEMENT FOR WARRIOR HALL AUDITORIUM ASSEMBLIES

- Maximum audience: per ADH guidelines
 - Likely 2 grades max (approx 250 people)
 - Two seats separating each participant (for performances, families may sit together)

Before Assembly:

- Exterior doors disinfected
- o Restrooms disinfected
- Exterior doors propped open
- Attendees enter through front doors
- Attendees will wear masks
- Attendees exit through side exterior doors based on side of auditorium in which they are sitting

- The division's Faculty & Staff will direct attendees and ensure compliance
- After Assembly:
 - Auditorium is cleaned & fumigated
 - Restrooms disinfected
 - Exterior doors disinfected
 - Lobby & hallways fumigated

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CLASSROOM DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT

Classroom Maximums:

- Choir Rooms = 15
- Band Room = 30
- Mac Lab = 15
- Ceramics = 10
- Theatre = 18
- Arena Classroom = 6/12
- HS Gym Classroom = 14

Physical Classroom Design:

- 6 ft. separation
- Utilize of outdoor space, lobbies, and auditorium as much as possible
- Air purifiers added to large classrooms and auditoriums

Supplies:

- ☐ Students share limited supplies and equipment
- ☐ All classroom supplies which were used are disinfected in part of end of class routine

Forgotten Supplies:

☐ Parents may bring forgotten supplies, equipment, instruments etc. and place these items in the bin outside Warrior Hall for delivery to students.

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MUSIC CLASSES

Masks:

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- Students playing woodwind and brass instruments will use a mask while playing which includes a small straight

- slit in a cloth mask. These masks will be provided.
- Bell covers, aka "Instrument masks" will also be provided and utilized for all woodwin and brass instruments

Distance:

- Indoor and outdoor spaces will be organized to maintain physical distancing of
 - Trombone = 9 feet
 - o flute/piccolo = 12 feet
 - Choir while singing = 12 feet
 - Everyone else = minimum 6 feet

Time:

 When actively playing instruments or singing, rehearsals will take place in 30minute increments, allowing for aerosol particles to settle and iar exchange to take place before the next rehearsal.

Airflow:

- All musicians should be facing the same direction while singing or playing.
- Large room air purifiers with medical grade H13 HEPA Filters have been added to the performing arts classrooms and warrior hall auditorium.
- UV Light filtration has been added to the HVAC system in Warrior Hall.

Hygiene:

- Swabbing and removal of water from wind instruments will take place outdoors.
- Storage rooms will only be used for the storage of personal items. Physical distancing of 6 feet will be maintained in the storage rooms.
- Students will use their own instruments.
 School instruments will be assigned to a single student, with the exception of percussion instruments, in which students will be issued individual drumsticks.

- Adjunct Instructors will be screened and temperature checked upon arrival to campus (Guard House or, if after hours, WH Desk)
- ☐ Private lessons are virtual for Lower School
- ☐ Private lessons are virtual or in-person for Upper School
- ☐ Group lessons are virtual

• Travel to competitions will likely require involvement with student's family

 Warrior Hall Audience capacity per active ADH guidelines and limited to family

Field Trips/ Guest Workshops:

- ☐ No field trips will be taken
- ☐ Guests may conduct workshops held in auditorium or classrooms following appropriate screening procedures (temperature & screening questions)

Fine Arts Academy:

- □ Adjunct Instructors will be screened and temperature checked upon arrival to campus (Guard House or, if after hours, WH Desk)
- □ Private lessons may occur on-site with social distancing; No EL/MS students in WH
- ☐ Pianos will be disinfected after each student
- ☐ Group lesson are virtual
- ☐ WH Staff will escort all students for pick up outside. Parents remain outside and do not come into the building for pick up.

PREVENTATIVE MEASURES Bathroom & Handwashing:

- One student at a time is allowed to leave the classroom.
- Strict physical distancing
- Hand washing procedures will be followed (taught in classrooms first two weeks of school)
- Bathrooms will be cleaned 2x a day, wiping counters, stall doors, and door handles

Daily Cleaning Procedures:

- Students will disinfect the classroom 5 minutes before the end of each block.
 Teachers will train and oversee this process.
- Warrior Hall Staff will disinfect all exterior doors after every class.
- Warrior Hall Staff will disinfect bathrooms 2 times each day.

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- Warrior Hall Staff will disinfect bathrooms 2 times each day.

Drinking Fountains:

- Retrofitted as dispensers for water bottles and may be use with social distancing
- Floors marked where lines may form

PPE:

☐ Face coverings required for guests, students, staff

Sanitizing Stations:

- Sanitizing Stations at entrance of each building
- Sanitizing Stations added to auditorium
- Waterless hand sanitizer available in each classroom
- Hand washing with soap will be utilized before students enter a classroom each block

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- Retrofitted as dispensers for water bottles and may be use with social distancing
- Floors marked where lines may form

PPE:

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- Waterless hand sanitizer available in each classroom
- Hand washing with soap will be utilized before students enter a classroom each block

PROCEDURES

Student Check Out:

- Parents call the divisional or Warrior Hall office. Office staff notifies the classroom teacher.
- ☐ Parents will wait outside for their child.

Teacher Shared Spaces:

- ☐ Refrigerator, microwave, and ice machine are available for use
- ☐ Following distancing guidelines, teachers may utilize the workroom

Visitors & Volunteers

- ☐ Visitors and volunteers will not enter the building
- Vendors will be limited and are required to wear face covering and follow strict physical distancing.

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Visitors & Volunteers:

- ☐ Visitors and volunteers will complete a screening questionnaire at the gate house or, if after hours, Warrior Hall front desk
- ☐ Gate House will notify the appropriate front office when guest arrives on campus
- ☐ All must check into the office upon arrival.
- ☐ Temperature screening will be completed at the office upon arrival
- ☐ All visitors and volunteers are required to follow social distancing.

Adjunct Instructors (Music Instructors who teach on campus weekly):

- ☐ Complete a Warrior Wellness Partnership Acknowledgement, and agree to abide by guidelines including daily temperature check before coming to campus. Kept on file with Director of Fine Arts Academy.
- ☐ Instructors will be issued a parking sticker for Gate House entrance.
- ☐ Instructors are required to follow social distancing procedures.
- ☐ Consider move to virtual private music lessons

Nurse's Office:

- Warrior Hall desk will continue to stock first aid, pain and allergy medicine, and record per protocol in RenWeb.
- Students who need temperature checks or medical triage will stop at the Warrior Hall desk first, then immediately go to the divisional nurse's office. The Warrior Hall desk will notify the nurse's office to expect the student. If a student requires assistance, WH staff will escort to nurse.

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- ☐ Lesson area will be disinfected by instructor between students.

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
