



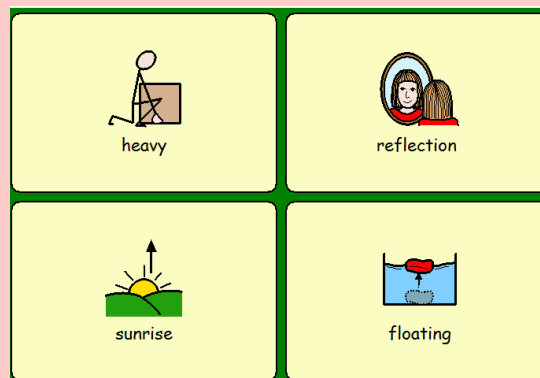
## Dear Parents and Carers 16.11.20
