Remember: Have a think about using the key vocabular when filling up your containers, is it full, ha full or empty?	nd Ty	Literacy/speaking: Last week we were helping Humpty Dumpty, now this week we are going to help Jack and Jill. Do the children know the Jack and Jill rhyme? Can you say it together?  Poor Jack and Jill keep falling down the hill. Can you make a plan to help keep them safe on the hill? If you do this through pictures, can you have a go at writing some labels and captions?  Remember: Think about what you want to draw / write. When writing words, think about what sounds you can hear and write those down.	STORYTIME – reading or listening to a story  reading/have-some-fun/storybooks-and-games/. Listen to each instrument and see which sounds you like or dislike. Can you explain why you did or did not like them? You can then have a go at recording your own piece of music by cliicking the record button and tapping the instruments you want to use.  Remember Think carefully about the instruments you are choosing. When using a computer, always make sure that a grown up knows what you are doing.

### W Phonics and reading – Sound swap

Today we are going to have a go at making some words and listening to the sounds to see which one we need to swap to make a different word.

Words to use:

Bag, tag, sag, sat, cat, mat, bat, bit, bag

#### Remember

You don't need to do all the words in one go you can do a few at a time

Say the word slowly to hear the sounds Remember to use the letter sounds and not the letter names.

Each word will only need one sound to change.

Log into bug club and read a story with you're grown up.

#### Remember:

To talk about what happened in the story and what you think might happen next to develop understanding and speaking and listening skills

Have a go at spotting the sounds that we have learnt at school.

Have a go at reading the words – say the sound and read the word.

### Literacy/speaking:

Think back to Monday, who were we helping, Jack and Jill! You thought of plans to help to keep them safe on the hill. Can you now have a go at writing them a letter to tell them all about your ideas?

#### Remember:

Think about what you want to write before you start.

Do one word at a time.

Remember to think about the sounds you can hear and write them down.

## Literacy - Handwriting:

Can you go over the sounds that you know and have a go at writing them?

The sounds are m, a, s, i, t, n, o, p, b, c, g, h.

Also, why don't you have a go at writing your name? See if you can write it in lots of different colours and lots of different sizes.

#### Remember:

Listen carefully with the instructions and make sure you start in the same place.



Jack and Jill want to create a map from their house to the hill so that they can remember how to get there and remember the way back again. They need to know everything that they might see on their journey.

#### Remember:

Think about what they might see on their journey.

Where is their house going to be? Where will the hill and well be? How long will it take them to get there?





#### Art/Understanding of the world:

When Jack and Jill have been carrying their water they have noticed that things keep falling in their bucket – some things drop to the bottom and some things stay on the top. Talk about the words floating and sinking and what this means.

Can you find some objects that you don't mind getting wet and predict whether they will float or sink in water? Have a go at putting these objects into some water to see what happens!

#### Remember -

Only choose objects that you don't mind getting wet

Have a go at explaining why you think they might float or sink
