This dashboard is updated weekly on Fridays and represents a snapshot of the current situation and data.

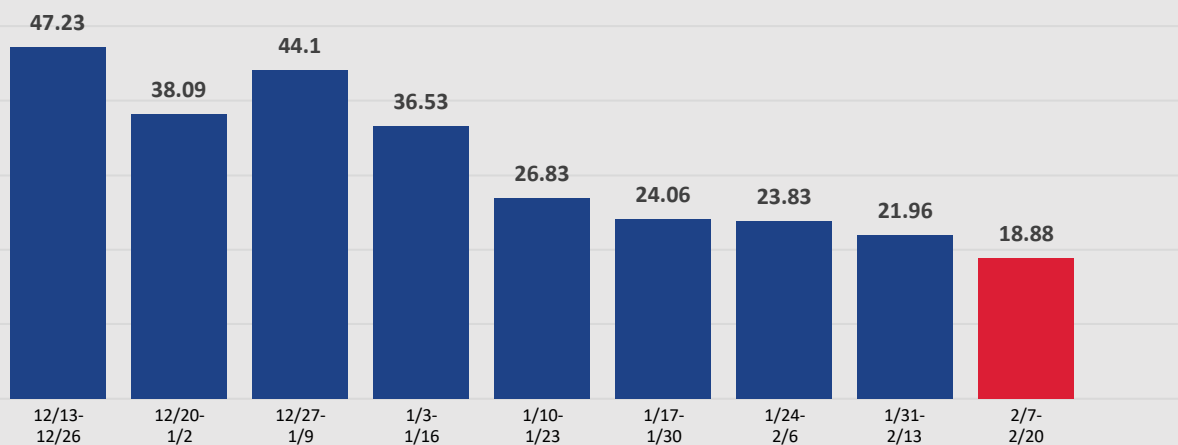
Spring Lake Park Schools works with our regional support team – including public health experts from Anoka County and Minnesota Department of Health – to understand county, district and school data and trends.

Situation this week

Spring Lake Park Schools students in grades preK-6 continue learning full-time at school. Students in grades 7-12 attending in a Modified Campus (hybrid) model will transition to learning at school five days per week on Tuesday, March 23. We continue to operate an Extended Flexible Learning model for families of K-12 students who choose it. Spring break for all students is March 12-22. Updates will not be posted during the break.

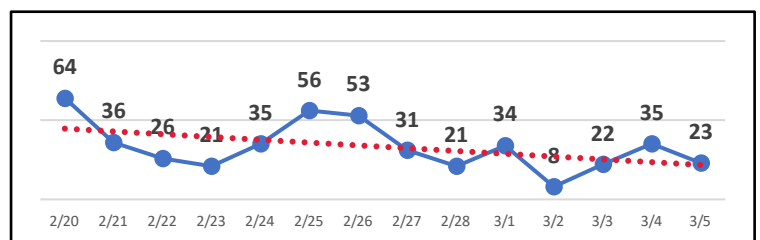
Anoka County 14-day case rate per 10,000 residents

This rate is the number of people who test positive per 10,000 residents. This data reported on Thursdays by Minnesota Department of Health continues to play a role in [Minnesota's Safe Learning Plan](#). The data lags by two weeks.



Anoka County daily new cases for the last 14 days

Because the 14-day case rate per 10,000 residents lags by two weeks, we also look at **total** daily new cases in the county for the last 14 days to preview what is coming. The [Minnesota Department of Health](#) reports case numbers each day for the previous day.
