**THS Announces Plans To Go All Virtual Nov. 16-20**

**TUPELO, Miss.** — Due to an outbreak of COVID-19 cases, Tupelo High School will transition to all virtual classes from Nov. 16-20.

On-campus classes will resume on Monday, Nov. 30, following the Thanksgiving Break.

This decision only affects the high school. All the other TPSD schools will remain open.

Administrators at all schools are prepared to transition to intermittent distance learning according to the language in the TPSD recovery plan.

Class attendance will be kept for all students at the high school during this virtual learning week.

Students will be expected to participate through CANVAS as if school is still open.

There will be no extra-curricular activities during this time, and all THS employees will be required to report to school as normal.
