Equity at Eastlake

Since 1990 the month of November has been recognized as Native American Heritage Month. The relationship between Indigenous Peoples and the United States' settler colonialist government is characterized by ethnic cleansing, forced assimilation and consistent violation of treaties painted to look like compromise but intended to dehumanize and displace. Despite these intentions, Indigenous Peoples have resisted, and fought for their humanity and basic human rights.

Last week we saw a contentious election between two political parties that, despite baseless accusations of voter fraud, continue to perpetuate this settler colonialist government otherwise known as a democratic republic.

Indigenous Peoples were not guaranteed the right to vote nationwide until 1962, but for many the right to vote is another amalgamation of forced assimilation. An Indigenous Perspective explained the difficult negotiations for Indigenous Peoples and the process of voting, "If voting is the democratic participation in our own oppression, voting as harm reduction is a politics that keeps us at the mercy of our oppressors... In our rejection of the abstraction of settler colonialism. we don't aim to seize colonial state power but to abolish it. We seek nothing but total liberation."

EHS stands with our Indigenous students, staff and community members in honor of their history, culture and liberation.





Technology Support While School is Remote

Students/Parents must contact FAMILY TECHNOLOGY ACCESS (FTA) to create a service ticket before coming to the school to solve technology problems (wifi internet box, stylus pen, working laptop).

Email ftaccess@lwsd.org or call 425-936-1322 Mon-Fri 7:00am - 7:00pm and include the following information to create the service ticket:

- School Name
- Student First Name and Last Name
- Grade
- Technology Need (or the problem?)

Once the FTA has this information and has created a ticket, the Eastlake on site tech representative will prepare a device and a library staff member will call you or email you with details about when and how to pick it up.

Free Internet Access Options

Reliable connectivity to the internet is critical for student success during remote teaching and learning. The state recognizes this need and has partnered with Ziplly Fiber, Comcast/Xfinity and Presidio to create [Washington's K-12 Internet Access Program](#), which gives eligible families free internet access so students can connect to online learning from home.

This internet access opportunity will potentially provide families with faster and more reliable connectivity than hotspots, which will better support our students. Eligible families can receive free internet access through June 30, 2021.

Parent/Student Access Into Eastlake During Open Hours

Eastlake High School is open during the following times:

- Mondays - 8-9AM

Please note that the building is not open on holidays/LEAP days
Enter on the side of the school by tennis court/buses, go up the stairs to the entry door during these specific times. Masks are required.

Our parking lot construction is coming to an end. However, due to COVID precautions, we are still requiring all students and visitors to enter the building only during our open hours, via the stairs by the bus loading zone on the East side of the building.

If students have an immediate need (i.e. malfunctioning laptop) that impedes their ability to participate in remote instruction,
