Solo and Ensemble Contest will be a live contest for the 2k20-2k21 school year.

All students are encouraged to participate this year.

Accompanists are not required for this year only. However, everyone will be socially distanced during the contest. No parents or family will be allowed in the contest area this year.

Students who receive an Outstanding Performance Award will perform in May at a recital at Memorial High School.

Students who choose to perform a solo or participate in an ensemble will receive 100 for the 3rd nine-weeks Project grades.

Students can perform any solo they choose with approval. Please see below for solo and ensemble options. When entering the pml, use the dropdown menu to help look at selections. The UIL grading system has grade 1 an advanced level, grade 2 an intermediate level, and grade 3 an average level.

SOLO AND ENSEMBLE ENTRY FORM

- CONTEST:** The MHS Solo & Ensemble Contest will take place at Memorial HS over two days:
1) Friday, Feb 19th from 3:30–7:00pm and 2) Saturday, Feb 20th from 9:00–1:00pm.
- FEES:** Solo entry fee: \$10 per person per event
Ensemble entry fee: \$10 per person per event (submit **ONE** form per ensemble)
- ENTRY DEADLINE:** Tuesday, Dec 1 2k20 at 3:15pm, checks payable to Memorial Orchestra
- MUSIC:** All selections must be approved. Ask Ms. P, or Mr. Chan if you would like help picking a piece. In order for a **solo** entry to be eligible for an Outstanding Performance, it must be performed from memory.
- SCORES:** You need to provide original music with all measures numbered for the judge.
- REGISTRATION:** Complete all lines below if applicable. **NO** changes allowed after the registration deadline.
