Thinking about getting ahead in college while you're still in high school?

Barry University's Dual Enrollment Program can help. We offer students at participating high schools the opportunity to earn high school and college credits right at their own schools. Since Dual Enrollment credits can be transferred to most public colleges and universities in Florida, you'll be saving yourself time and money later and possibly be able to graduate from college early.



There are many benefits to taking part in Barry's Dual Enrollment Program. You can:

- Learn what it's like to take a college class.
- Gain access to tutoring at Barry along with library, career, and counseling services.
- Get an official Barry transcript indicating college credits earned, transferable to most universities.
- Save money on college tuition and potentially graduate college early.
- Receive an annual tuition discount as an undergraduate student at Barry.

Program Eligibility Requirements:

- Junior or Senior high school standing
- At least a 3.0 unweighted high school GPA or testing equivalent, if homeschooled
- Must attend a partner high school
- Parent/guardian and high school's approval
- Approved Dual Enrollment application
- Acquire the minimum standardized college placement and/or college readiness score according to the Florida Department of Education's Common Placement Testing standards. Additional minimal test scores may be required for higher level courses.

Additional Information:

- If you wish to continue taking Barry courses after high school, you must formally apply to the university.
- Dual Enrollment course offerings depend on the high school's preferences and scheduling.
- Courses vary by school and semester. Contact your Guidance Counselor for details.

3 Frequently asked questions about Barry University's Dual Enrollment Program

Where are the dual enrollment classes taught?

At designated high school sites or on Barry University's campus.

Who pays the college tuition for Dual Enrollment?

Students are not required to pay any Dual Enrollment tuition, laboratory fees, or special fees to Barry University.

Are dual enrollment course credits transferable?

Yes, Dual Enrollment credits will transfer to most public universities in the state of Florida. However, students are encouraged to contact the college or university of their choice to ensure the credits will be accepted at those institutions.
