

- ☒ Submit official transcript & test scores
- ☒ Test scores not needed with 3.00+

Rolling: hear back in 2-3 weeks

Admission Guidelines

GPA: 2.75 or higher (4.00 scale)

- Weighted or unweighted; we use the highest
- What's reported on the official transcript; will convert to 4.00 scale if needed

SAT & ACT are not needed with GPA 3.00+

SAT: 1110 or higher (530 math preferred)

ACT: 22 or higher

Grades and classes: Look at trends

Final transcript: Required prior to enrollment—a significant decline in academic performance during the senior year may affect enrollment status

Transfer students: \$5,000 to \$10,000

Leading Scholar Award

Apply by October 15 of your senior year

One-page essay & recommendation letter

Up to 200 finalists selected for a virtual competition

Multiple finalists receive full tuition

Finalists who participate receive \$20,000

Renewable for 4 years (8 semesters)

Children and grandchildren of alumni: in-state tuition
