School Attendance Area

Requests to change attendance areas shall be made in writing to the Superintendent of Schools. Permission for attendance waivers shall be at the Superintendent's discretion based on the enrollment in the grade at the school affected by the request and shall be of one school year duration, unless otherwise noted.

Elementary School Districts

All elementary school students shall attend the elementary schools situated in the school district in which they reside. Boundaries for each district shall be as established by the Board of Education.

The boundaries for the elementary schools are as follows:

DEANS MILL SCHOOL

North - North Stonington town line

East - Stoneybrook Road, including D'Amato, Knight and Sherwood, Taugwonk Road, Pequot Trail, South Anguilla Road, including Anguilla Brook, Greenhaven Road, Mary Hall Road to the Pawcatuck River

South - Shoreline

West - Groton town line

WEST VINE STREET SCHOOL

North - North Stonington town line. Mayflower and Route I to Edwards Street, to Morgan and Liberty, west side of Liberty to 24 Stillman, Stillman to Garden

East - Westerly town line

South - North of Walnut, north of 24 Stillman, east side of Liberty to Morgan to Edwards to Route I to South Anguilla, including Lathrop, Holly, Parkwood, West Enterprise and Cronin. Pawcatuck River, north of Mary Hall Road

West - East of South Anguilla, North Anguilla, including Miner Pentway. Pawcatuck Avenue to Route I and Mayflower Avenue
