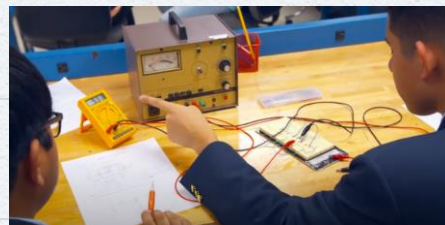

4. Enroll in College Classes

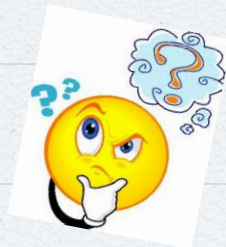
HOW CAN YOU BE A PART OF ECHS OR P-TECH?

- x ALL eighth grade students in GISD are eligible to apply.
 - X No test scores required - Justy apply!
 - x Ideal candidates are motivated, determined, and committed!
 - x Space is Limited.
 - X 125 for ECHS
 - X 125 for P-TECH
 - X 25 seats for Auto Tech
 - X 20 seats for Mechatronics
 - X 80 seats for Teaching
 - X Weighted Lottery if there are more applicants than available seats

MAGNET APPLICATION & CHOICE OF SCHOOL



- ✗ Choice of School forms are **separate** from the Magnet Application.
 - ✗ If you want to apply for a magnet program, you have to fill out the Magnet Application.
- ✗ Students entering ninth grade should **also** complete a Choice of School form.
- ✗ A Choice of School form ensures you have turned in your choices in case your student does not qualify for a magnet program or is waitlisted for a magnet program.


