Dear Parents and Guardians,

We have been notified that an individual at Lincoln Elementary School has tested positive for COVID-19. Individuals, if any, who have been in **close contact** with the person testing positive have already been notified. As a result of this case and in consultation with the Edison Township Health Department, New Jersey Department of Health, and CDC protocols, **Lincoln Elementary School will shift to all remote learning starting Friday, November 20, 2020, for a period of 14 days.** We anticipate that students and staff can return to school for in-person instruction on Friday, December 4, 2020.


At this time, the shift to remote learning only applies to Lincoln Elementary School. All other district schools will remain open for in-person learning as scheduled in our hybrid model.
