R713-1 USE OF POOL

- I. General Statement
 - 1. Priority of use for the Pool shall be given to students attending Lower Merion School District. During the regular school day, the facilities will be made available as teaching stations for Lower Merion School District students.
 - 2. The facilities shall be under the direct jurisdiction of the Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee.
 - 3. When the pool is not needed for District programs, the facility shall be made available for community use in accordance with a schedule and program administered by the District's contracted Community Swim Program Administrator.
 - 4. The facilities shall be administered only by personnel employed by or in the employ of a firm contracted by the District.
- II. Personnel, Equipment and Supplies
 - 1. The Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee will requisition equipment and supplies for pool operations from the Operations Department via the usual procedures for requisitioning equipment and supplies for the high school.
- III. Types of Programs to be Submitted to the Superintendent or the Superintendent's Designee
 - 1. School programs (classes, teams and meets).
 - 2. Classes and programs when the pool is not being used by the District.
 - 3. Summer programs or programs during vacation periods.
- IV. Schedules, Assignments and Administrative Policy
 - 1. The Community Swim Program Administrator shall develop the schedules in cooperation with other Lower Merion School District administrators.

- 2. Fees for use of the natatorium will be charged according to a fee schedule which shall be periodically updated and included in a regulation issued pursuant to this policy.
- V. General Regulations
 - 1. All persons using the facilities of the pool must use school equipment.
 - 2. The Superintendent or the Superintendent's designee shall establish procedures, including but not limited to, a system of identification of users of the pool to ensure that they are District residents, employees or other authorized users.
