How to Apply: Persons must call in early November. Call for an appointment to register as a food bank client. Client MUST bring photo identification, proof of current address, proof of income and Social Security cards for all members of household. Client MUST be registered to receive assistance.

Hopelink, Redmond - Holiday Food Program

Provides holiday food for eligible low-income local residents by appointment only.
