



5th Grade Individual Quarantine Plan

In case of individual quarantine, here is the framework that will be used for 5th grade students. Teachers are teaching in person all day Monday-Thursday and will not be providing daily, separate delivery for students on quarantine.

Parents will need to contact the individual teacher to arrange a time to pick up the iPad from the office and any other learning tools that the student may need.

Students on quarantine will participate in school by:

- 1) Face to face, real time lessons via TEAMS. Students will use their device at home to join their class at school to receive instruction. Any worksheets that accompany this face to face lesson time can be found on Canvas. (Parents will notify the individual teacher if the student is able to join the class).
- 2) Students will also have independent learning which may include: District videos, McGraw Hill lessons, Imagine Math, i-Ready reading, Nearpod and Studies Weekly. These will be teacher directed assignments.

Students have been using Canvas in class and have the competency skills to navigate this system.

Schedule for face to face, real time lessons via TEAMS:

Monday – Thursday (4 hours face time)

9:00 – 10:20 – Language Arts lessons (except on Library days)

12:30 – 3:15 – Math, Science and Writing rotations

Friday

Fridays will continue to be independent learning days on Canvas, Imagine Math, i-Ready, Studies Weekly or Nearpod. Teachers will meet with students in small groups, individually or as a class ***if necessary***.

Parents may contact the teacher on Friday between 10:30 – 11:00.

Teachers will work with Mrs. Egbert and other related servers to make sure that students with IEP's are getting their service times.
