

<u>Care Program Protocols, Schedule</u> <u>& Frequently Asked Questions</u>

The Care Program is designed to meet the needs of working parents of Junior and Middle School students who want their children to do their homework and be engaged in relaxing activities after school hours. It provides a dependable daily program in a warm and safe environment. The Care Program runs every school day from 3:00 PM to 5:30 PM.

IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION:

The Care Program is required to follow the safety measures in place at UNIS.

Due to the constraints of Covid 19 pandemic and the obligation to social distancing, only limited number registrations on full-time basis are available

The JS Care meets in the cafeteria. The MS Care meets in the gymnasium and/or cafeteria. The JS parents are reminded to update the **School Dismissal Manager (SDM)** to reflect the schedules changes. The Junior School dismissing teachers direct the students accordingly. The parents are also reminded to indicate any allergies or restrictions the students may have.

- End of program Dismissal / Pick-up The Security guard, at the entrance of the school will call to inform the Care supervisors. The JS students are escorted to the tent (unless otherwise instructed by the security guards). After 5:15pm: students are picked up in the tent. MS students are allowed to go to the tent.

Homework

• The students may complete their homework in the Care Program in accordance with UNIS Student Parent Handbook. Parents will be made aware at pick-up time if their child has not been able to finish their homework or had difficulty completing it.

PARENTS FREQUENTLY ASKEED QUESTIONS

- Who can pick-up my child? Parents are required to list the caregivers/babysitters on the portal/SDM. The security guards will not allow pickups to undocumented/not listed caregivers/babysitters.
- Where do I pick up my child? Between 3:00 to 5:30pm the Security guard, at the entrance of the school will call to inform the Care supervisors The JS student are escorted to the tent (unless otherwise instructed by the security guards). MS students may directly go to the tent.
- What do I do if I am running late after 5:30PM? If parents are running late we ask that they inform the front desk security guard at 212-684-7400



- How does my child get to the Care Program? The homeroom teacher hands over to the Care Leaders the students registered in the Care Program.
