Learning Focus

Language Arts

Students have been focusing on creating an organized narrative writing. Some of the key elements needed are: setting, characters, plot (problem) solution, conclusion.

▼ Details: Words that are used to recreate an experience, feelings, or image to allow the reader to transport himself or herself into a scene.

▼ Multi-word title: Using two or more word to attract the reader.

▼ Hook: Interesting topic sentence to begin your paragraph that grabs the readers attention.

▼ Transitions: Using transitional and Temporal Words to begin sentences that a particular time, cause, or reason. Example: According to the Channel 5 News, the weather is going to be very hot.

▼ Simple Sentences: The most basic parts that make a sentence, a subject, a verb, and a complete thought. Example: The cat was black.

▼ Compound Sentences: Consists of two independent clauses (a simple sentence) and have more than one subject, and more than one verb, and they are two complete thoughts joined together. Example: We want to go to the library, but it is closed today.

▼ Conclusion sentence: Relates to the topic sentence for closure in a paragraph.

Math

All students, when solving math problems, need to show that they have read, drawn, and wrote equations with labeling, to show their math steps when solving all math problems. Especially when solving the following types of math problems.

▼ Properties of Multiplication:

▼ Commutative Property of Multiplication: The order of the number are multiplied does not change the product. Example: $4 \times 5 = 5 \times 4$

▼ Associative Property of Multiplication: The way in which numbers are grouped does not change their product. Example: $(3 \times 2) \times 6 = 3 \times (2 \times 6)$

▼ Identity Property of Multiplication: The product of 1 any number is that number. Example: $7 \times 1 = 7$

▼ Zero Property of Multiplication: If 0 is multiplied by a number, the product is 0. Example: $11 \times 0 = 0$

▼ Area: Length \times Width ($L \times W$). The total number of square units that cover a figure.

▼ Division: To split in to equal parts or groups.
