EMERGENCY DISMISSAL, CLOSING, or DELAYED OPENING POLICY

- A) In general, Oakwood School considers other local school systems when determining early dismissals, delayed openings, and closures due to inclement weather or other such emergency situations. On the very rare occasion that Oakwood School departs from local school systems (only for issues that do not affect Oakwood, e.g. extreme cold, school busing issues, prolonged cancelation due to isolated county issues, etc.), we will be sure to inform families as far in advance as possible through our Parent Notification System. (See full policy in Student/Parent Handbook)
- B) If Oakwood School has a delayed opening, it will always be a 2-hour delay. School will start at 10:30 a.m.
- C) If there is a delayed opening on any **Monday**, Oakwood will remain in session until **3:00 p.m.**
- D) In the event Oakwood School needs to dismiss early due to inclement weather, Oakwood will utilize the Parent Notification System to notify our parents of the early dismissal. If Oakwood dismisses early due to inclement weather or another emergency, there will be **NO** Afternoon Extended Day.
- E) For **ALL** Emergency Dismissal situations, Oakwood School will utilize its Parent Notification System to email, text, and/or call families of the proper procedures and necessary information.
- F) **Make-up Policy** – The Commonwealth of Virginia requires accredited schools to have a minimum of 990 instructional hours each school year or 180 instructional days averaging 5.5 hours a day. As an accredited school, licensed by the Virginia Board of Education, Oakwood School not only meets, but exceeds this requirement. Our annual calendar schedules more than 180 days equaling 1030 instructional hours in a school year. The Code of Virginia, Section 22.1-98 also indicates that, if a school offers more than the minimum instructional hours required, those additional hours, or the day equivalents, may be used to offset any time missed for inclement weather or other emergencies, without having to make up all of those days or hours. Since Oakwood School has a large excess of hours above the required 990, no make-up days would be legally necessary. However, Oakwood will always exceed minimum legal requirements in order to serve the needs of our students. Our calendar acknowledges the need of our students and their families for ample instructional hours, but also predictable, regularly scheduled breaks and holidays around which they can plan. Therefore, only after Oakwood has missed 7 days of school we will begin to make up days. A specific make-up schedule will be released if it becomes necessary.
