**Internet Safety Training** 

District uses iBoss filtering for district devices including iPads, Chromebook/Cloud Book, and Dell laptops. Main apps are Skype, Mystery Science, Zoom, iReady, Nearpod, Utah Compose, Teams, Heggerty, McGraw Hill, Imagine Learning, and Canvas. Tech use to enhance learning and personalization. The district uses Net Safe Utah to train students in safety.

Review School Improvement Plan Goals 2020-2021

- 1. Oral reading fluency. Our school is 3.6% behind results from last year with the transition from Kindergarten to first grade suffering the most. Mrs. Paras will look into the same transition data from other years. All actions items are in place for future success.
- 2. Math. We don't have end of level tests from last year to use. Also, because of Covid difficulties, we haven't been able to do math tutoring this year. Teachers are using grade level assessments to determine success and say that they do seem to be on track to reaching their goals. We discussed different tutoring going on from student to student. Also, teachers are available on Fridays for any students who need extra help.
- 3. SEL. Teacher development ongoing. Staff is reading Power of a Teacher. 3 tiers of teaching for students. First, all students receive lessons. Next is restorative practices and calm spaces if needed. Third would be very individualized work with the SEL committee. Student Hope Squad members will go in pairs during certain recesses with the objective to help those students who appear to need it. Mrs. Paras will bring up what our school is doing with her next Northridge Cluster meeting so the junior high and high school might get on board.
