RHS YEARBOOKS



Next week: Yearbook sales will begin on **November 23 and close on December 18.**

Parents or students may purchase yearbooks on the school website where they pay fees. To do this select the "yearbook" option. Yearbooks are \$65.

This is the first of three sales windows. The next two windows will be open in winter and spring 2021.

FREE INTERNET FOR ELIGIBLE FAMILIES



New: Reliable connectivity to the internet is critical for student success during remote teaching and learning. The state recognizes this need and has partnered with Ziply Fiber, Comcast/Xfinity and Presidio to create Washington's K-12 Internet Access Program, which gives eligible families free internet access so students can connect to online learning from home.

This internet access opportunity will potentially provide families with faster and more reliable connectivity than hotspots, which will better support our students. Eligible families can receive free internet access through June 30, 2021.

PSAT FOR 11th GRADERS



PSAT/NMSQT Opportunity for 11th Graders

Sign Up by December 2

Pending health and safety conditions, the Lake Washington School District plans to offer the PSAT/NMSQT on Tuesday, January 26, 2021 to <u>current 11th graders</u>

that sign up by December 2.

The PSAT/NMSQT is the Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test. The purpose of the PSAT is to familiarize students with the kinds of questions, style of directions, and physical environment of an SAT exam, and provides students with a projected SAT score range, personalized feedback, and a study plan. Eleventh grade students who take the PSAT/NMSQT are also automatically screened for the National Merit®Scholarship Program; an academic competition for recognition and scholarships.

Any 11th graders that would like to take the PSAT in January should complete the **sign up form** by December 2. The cost is \$17. Payment will be taken closer to the actual exam.

Reporting an Absence:

WORLD LANGUAGE OPPORTUNITY



New: After school programs for Spanish, Russian and Romanian Heritage Speakers

OSPI in collaboration with the World Affairs Council is funding an exciting program for heritage speakers of Spanish, Russian, and Romanian (students 14 years old+). These *free*, virtual after school programs aim to connect students with other heritage speakers of their language around the state, engaging in interesting learning and projects, and improving their language and intercultural proficiency. Students can earn the Global Competency Certificate and will be offered the Seal of Biliteracy Testing at no cost, for which they can earn up to 4 high school credits, depending on their proficiency (the same testing we offer in-district, but students test through the program).



TECH HELP AT RHS



When having software issues, students should still contact ftaccess@lwsd.org or phone 425-936-1322 for the Family Technology Access support line.

Two recent and crucial service improvements for families include offering an **automated call back and/or automated VM to ticket options** to the Family Technology Access line as well as **language interpretive services** during our 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. hours of support 7 days a week.

However, for hardware issues, Redmond High offers in-person tech help. To access this service, use the driveway east of the main entrance, labeled *Deliveries and Staff Only*. Park your car next to the sign for the library, and wearing a mask, walk up to the back door of the library.

Note: this is an outdoor service, so *come dressed for the weather*. We are open from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m., Monday - Friday.
