HIGHLIGHTS OF THE FALL

CROSS COUNTRY

- ❖ Due to the pandemic, the team hosted four home meets, defeating Regina and DePaul.
- ❖ Veronica Dworak received “All-Conference” Athletic honors for her strong finish at the GCAC meet.
- ❖ The team finished 4th at Regionals, qualifying for Sectionals. Veronica Dworak took 3rd individually, and Mary Stachula took 15th.
- ❖ Maeve Hogan, Emma Kantor, Caleigh Ryle, Nina Boyd, Rachael Lally, Nora McGovern, Veronica Dworak, and Mary Stachula represented the Bandits at Sectionals. All finishing with their best race times of the season.

GOLF

- ❖ Overall Record: 4-5. CGAC Record: 4-4
- ❖ Biggest Victory: Defeating Trinity.
- ❖ Key wins: Montini and Regina
- ❖ Eileen Schenfeld netted a “hole in one” during match play. She is the first Resurrection golfer to do so.
- ❖ The team played great at Regionals. Shooting an all-time low for Resurrection golf. Due to the covid restrictions this year, it was not enough to advance on to Sectionals.

SWIMMING

- ❖ Caroline Murray was Team Captain and Bella Martinelli was the Spirit Captain.
- ❖ Nine new swimmers joined the program this year. All were eager to learn and worked hard. The hard worked paid off with all nine new swimmers achieving personal bests at the final MCAC meet.
- ❖ Spirit Captain Bella Martinelli along with the seniors on JV lead the way for the JV team. Encouraging and pushing the girls to be their best!
- ❖ The Varsity team continuously dropped times throughout the season and reached its best marks by Sectionals.
- ❖ Varsity Seniors Caroline Murray and Sydney Danner finished their Resurrection careers strongly, competing well at Sectionals.
- ❖ What the coaches are proudest of with this group of girls, is even with the shortened season and the restrictions, almost 100% of the girls managed to improve throughout the season, earning their fastest times in the pool at the final meet.

TENNIS – VARSITY

- ❖ Conference Record: 2-3
- ❖ Finished 5th at GCAC Tournament.
- ❖ Senior Casey Brannigan had a 7-1 record overall, finishing 3rd at the GCAC Tournament.
- ❖ Over 40 girls were at tennis tryouts this year. The team took higher than normal numbers as a result of this, hoping to build the tennis program for next year.
- ❖ The team competed hard at sectionals on a cold and rainy day, Casey Brannigan won her first round match before losing to the eventual finalist.

- ❖ Phenomenal team record considering all girls joined the team with no previous tennis experience.
- ❖ All players learned new tennis skills and match play procedures.
- ❖ Development of ball control achieved by stronger players.

- ❖ Olivia Komosa and Nicole Carr had an outstanding 6-1 record as a doubles team.
- ❖ This was Resurrections youngest JV team in quite some time, almost entirely freshmen, with a few sophomores.
